Description of Training Sessions

The Markel/USEF Young Horse Dressage Training Sessions are open training sessions. Professionals are encouraged to bring their talented young horses to the training sessions even if they are not planning to qualify for the Markel/USEF Young Horse Dressage Championships.

The two-day training sessions will include a forty-five minute lesson each day with Scott Hassler as well as an evening lecture and discussion for the riders led by Scott.

Application for Training Sessions

Cost of Training Sessions

The cost of the Young Horse Training Sessions will be \$200 for the two days. This fee will include the two forty-five minute sessions, the evening lecture and two auditing passes. Fees will be paid directly to USEF and collected prior to the clinic. There may be an additional fee for stabling charged by the host site. A maximum of ten horse/rider combinations will be accepted for the Training Session.

Scheduling of Training Sessions

Time slots will be assigned on a first come-first serve basis. Invitations will be extended via email through the USEF Dressage Department. It is the athlete's responsibility to ensure USEF has received notification of acceptance.

Auditing

Auditors will be permitted at the training sessions however they must be registered with the host site. Please contact Halle Griffin, Director of National Dressage Programs, for further information.
